The RHLF Fellow should be self-motivated, have a strong work ethic, and is interested in water quality, conservation, environmental engineering, and community engagement. - Manage Rain Barrel inventory
- Conduct community outreach and Rain Barrel installation workshops
- Transport and Distribute Rain Barrels
- Manage and Maintain litter-trap installations
- Assist in CRK day-to-day operations
