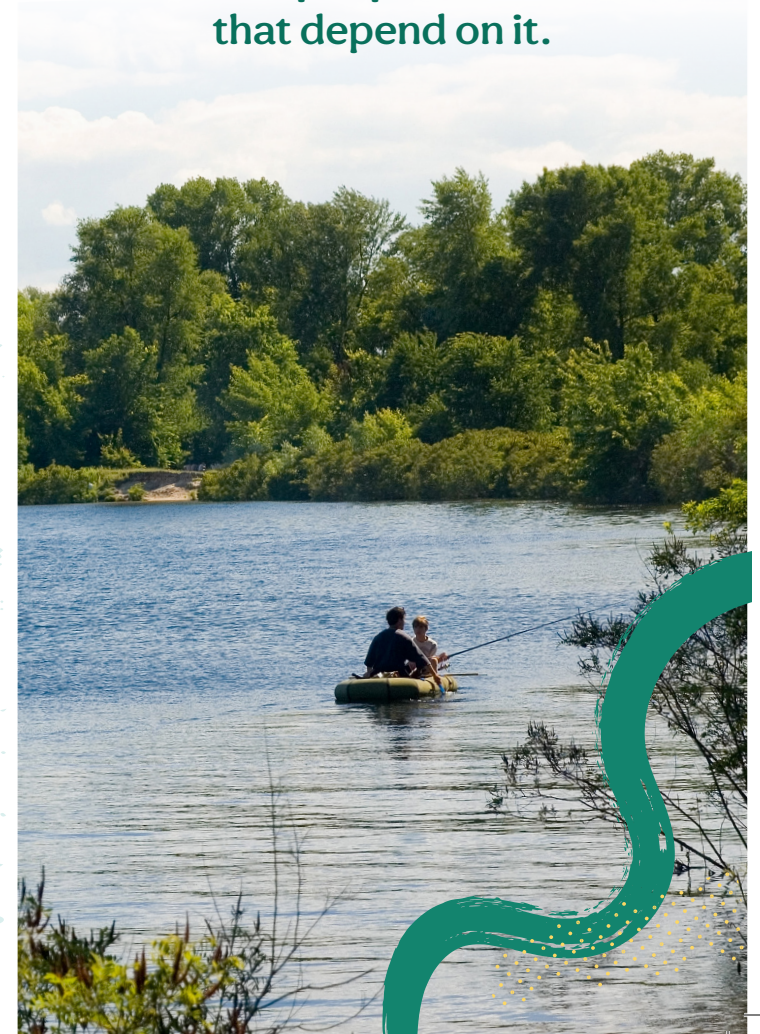

About the Chattahoochee River



Derived from the Creek words meaning "painted rock," the Chattahoochee River begins as a small spring in north Georgia and flows 435 miles south to the Apalachicola River. Along the way, this liquid lifeline faces threats including stormwater and wastewater pollution, increasing demand from human consumption, and the effects of a changing climate.

The Chattahoochee River is one of the smallest river systems in the entire country to provide water supply to a major metropolitan region and sustain fresh drinking water for more than five million people. Chattahoochee Riverkeeper is the only nonprofit organization dedicated entirely to protecting all of the Chattahoochee watershed.
